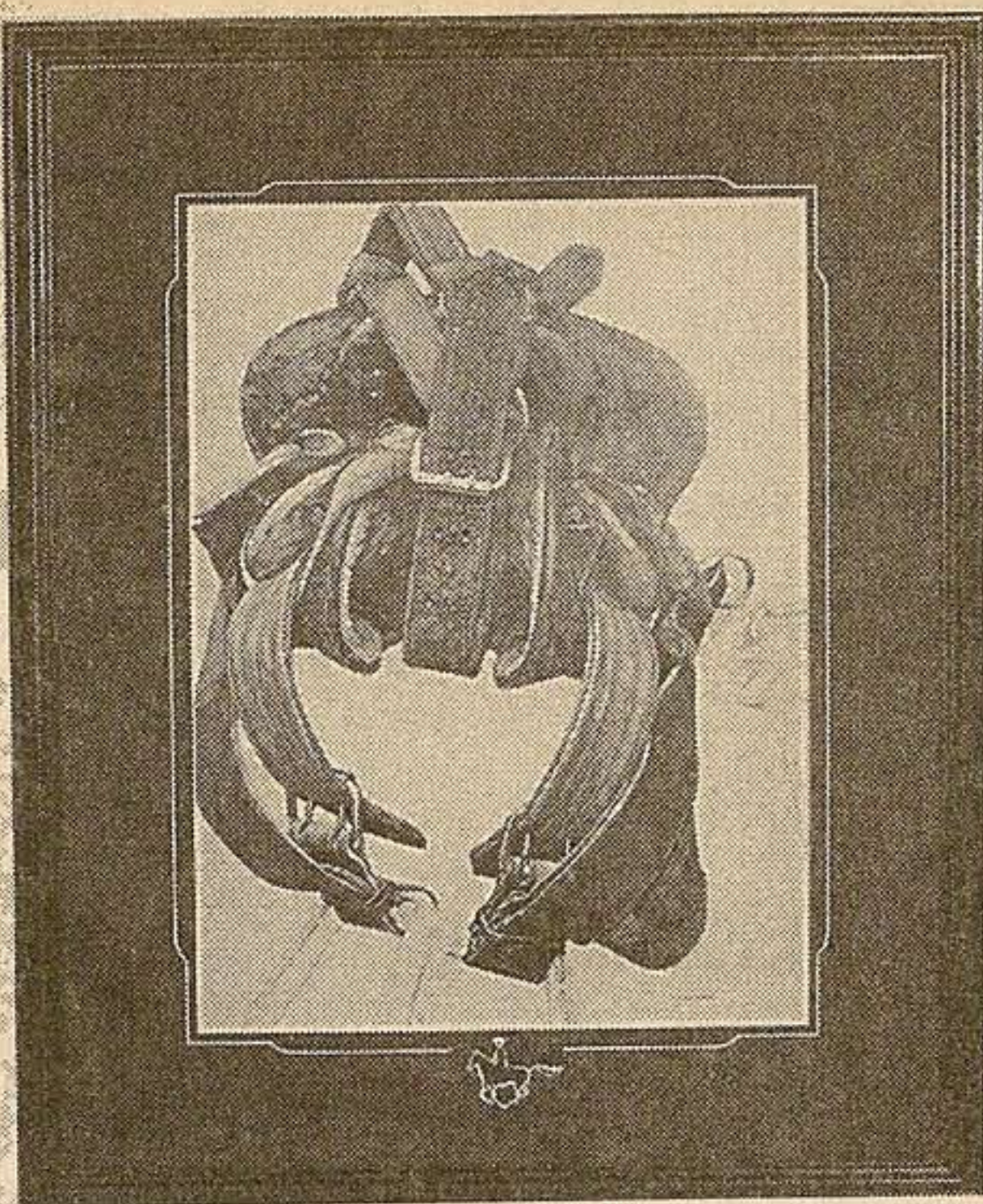

Roxanne Martin is an accomplished Edmonton artist who uses the professional photographs she takes as inspiration for her graphite drawings. She graduated with an honors degree in Fine Arts from the University of Alberta and began her professional career with a solo show at the SUB Gallery in 1974. A highlight in her career was the creation of the first graphite show for her works at the prestigious Woltjen-Udell Gallery in 1984, where she was featured along side such artists as Christopher Pratt and Andy Warhol. Martin's continuing desire is to bring the character of Rodeo a wider appreciation and she has donated much of her work to Rodeo benefit causes. Her fine works can be found in many corporate and private collections throughout North America. At present Martin resides in Edmonton where she teaches art at Avalon Junior High in addition to her professional photography and graphite artistry.
